

Which tail leads to the treasure?

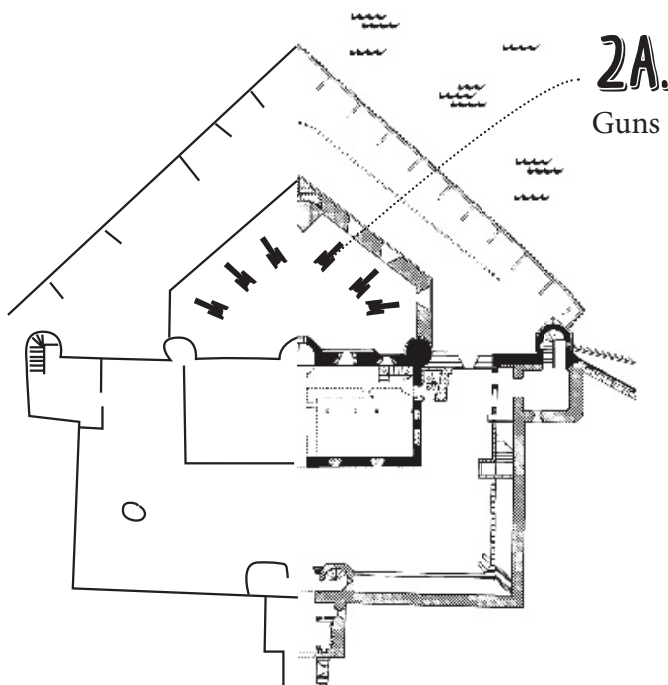
Answer: C

 Wooden spikes up high - **to kill you**
 A drawbridge - **so you fall in the ditch**
 Guns - **to shoot you**
 Thick stone walls - **to keep out cannonballs**

Ones that are still here: **studded door, wooden spikes and thick stone walls**

3. How many cannons do you think were here in 1667 - **9**

- 6 - Pour some loose gunpowder into the priming hole
- 7 - Aim and stand back
- 2 - Clean the barrel
- 8 - Touch the priming hole with a burning rope
- 4 - Load the cannonball
- 1 - Remove any hot material from the barrel
- 5 - Stab a hole in the powder bag through the priming hole
- 3 - Push a bag of powder down the barrel
